





5. (15 points) You are taking care of bees on the Simon's Rock Community Farm. You just set up a queen in a new hive, and while the hive is youngexponential growth is a good model for the population. On day 0, when you started the new hive, you counted 100 bees in the hive. One week later you counted 120 bees. Write a formula which describes the population B(t) of bees t days after you started the hive. Use this formula to predict the population two weeks after the start. Give an exact answer.

Give an exact answer and simplify fully. [Hint: your final answer should be a rational number.]
